

## **How To Find a Great House for Rent Without Getting Ripped Off!**

Visit the place beforehand and assess the following: Check the time you need to get there from the main centres/infrastructure. Do you need to drive? Is it walkable? Can you easily catch a bus, Uber, Bolt or taxi there if you don't have transport? ☐ Check the condition of any sandy roads and whether they will be passable in heavy rain ☐ Check if the noise level in the evenings & the weekends suits you ☐ Check the contract you are going to sign beforehand 1. Who pays for regular repairs, leaking roof, problems with the appliances/air conditioning/pool etc. 2. How much rent do you have to pay in advance? 3. What are the bond requirements? 4. What time frame are you committed to? ☐ Summer Challenges - Check there is sufficient air conditioning/fans and airflow for every room, check that you can cross ventilate every room. Check all the air conditioners are clean and well maintained. ☐ Winter challenges - Check if the heating is sufficient for all the rooms in the house. Check the potential for mold - check if you can cross ventilate every room and dry every room with air conditioning ☐ Check for mosquitos - Check every door and window has mosquito screens Other points that may be important to you: ☐ Is the fridge big enough? ☐ Every room has big windows? ☐ Are the water heaters big enough to shower everyone in the house? □ Is the house easy to keep clean - tiles etc?

$\hfill\square$ If it is furnished does it have enough pots, plates, cutlery, towels etc
□ Does it have a washing machine & a place to dry clothes?
$\ \square$ Is the property safe & secure? Has there been any break ins?(Ask the
landlord)
